



Dr. Barrett W. Zink

September 27, 1951 - August 13, 2017

Barrett "Barry" Wallace Zink, 65, of Charlotte died unexpectedly on Sunday, August 13, 2017. Dr. Zink was a beloved husband, father, grandfather and physician. Dr. Zink graduated from MSU College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1976. He practiced in the Charlotte area from 1977 to 2017 in Family Practice, and later transitioned to Urgent Care at Hayes Green Beach Hospital.

Dr. Zink enjoyed traveling with his wife, RC helicopter flying, drag racing and motorcycle riding. He also liked being outdoors doing downhill and cross country skiing. His favorite pastime was spending time with his granddaughters.

He is survived by his wife of 39 years Elaine; sons Kurt (Daile) Zink and Eric (Amber) Zink; granddaughters Riley, Cora, Sadie, and Libby Jo; mom Dorothy Zink; and brother Bill (Vicki) Zink. Barry was predeceased by his dad, Rev. Wallace Zink.

Funeral Mass will be celebrated Saturday, August 19, 2017, 11:00 a.m. at St. Mary Catholic Church in Charlotte with Rev. Fr. Dwight Ezop officiating. Visitation is Thursday 2-4 p.m., 6-8 p.m. and Friday 5-7:30 p.m. with a Rosary Service at 7:30 p.m. at Pray Funeral Home.
