

Thanksgiving and Christmas was always special in our family and Sheila helped make it that way. She made some of the best cookies ever. We use to have pool parties at our house and we had this square board that you could float on. We would run off the deck and jump on it to surf. Sheila being a good sport said she would try...she couldn't jump very far so we had it close but that didn't matter, she jumped hit the board it went flying up in the air and she went splashing down in the water. To this day I laugh every time I think of it. There are lots more but now my best memory is last summer her and I took a day and went to Lake Michigan, ate lunch, shopped in Holland and just had a blast! I wish I would of done that a hundred more times. Sheila was the bravest person I've known. She fought for her life for the last two years against cancer, knowing that it would be the toughest fight of her life and she never gave up. She went for treatments sometimes everyday, she got good news than bad news. One day things looked good then the next day not so good. And she did this during Covid 19 where she had to be extra careful. And she lost her husband 8 months after she found out she had cancer.

Sheila I miss you more than I could ever say and this country lost a very special lady, but I know God is smiling because he knows he got a very special lady.
