



Agnes Therese Lautner

October 11, 1931 - June 26, 2016

Agnes Therese Lautner, 84, of Charlotte, died peacefully surrounded by her family on Sunday, June 26, 2016 in Charlotte. Agnes was born October 11, 1931 in St. Louis, MO, the daughter of Leo A. and Ida M. (Wehmeyer) Saale. She graduated from Marquette High School in Alton, IL, before marrying Lester Lautner on September 22, 1951. Lester served in the U.S. Army and was stationed at Fort Bragg, NC, before settling in Alton, IL. In 1964, they moved to Charlotte, MI, where Lester worked for Owens Illinois and Agnes raised their 5 children. Later, she worked as the bus driver for St. Mary School, as well as a clerk for Sherman Pharmacy and several years at the Country Mill.

Throughout the years, Agnes was very generous in volunteering her time. Agnes and Lester were instrumental in the development of the St. Vincent DePaul of St. Mary. She also served on the Altar Society. She was a 4-H leader, Camp Fire Leader, worked with mobile meals, volunteered at SIREN Eaton Shelter and at community dinners at the Eagle's Club.

Agnes enjoyed quilting, sewing, gardening, camping and playing the piano. She and Lester served as Foster Parents to many children. Above all, Agnes put her Faith and her family first. She is survived by her son, Teddy (Sherry) Lautner of Attica, MI; daughter, Therese (Dan) Lake of Charlotte; daughter, Carol (Debbie Petersen) Schilling of Clinton Twp.; daughter, Cheryl (Edward)

Wright of Holly; son, Joseph (Maria) Lautner of Charlotte; 20 grandchildren; 17 great-grandchildren; and brother Joseph Saale of Wentzville, MO. She was predeceased by her husband of 59 years, Lester M. Lautner in 2010 and her daughter-in-law, Sue Lautner in 2012.

Funeral services will be 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, June 29, 2016 at St. Mary Catholic Church, Charlotte, MI with Rev. Father David Rosenberg officiating. Interment will be in Maple Hill Cemetery, Charlotte, MI. 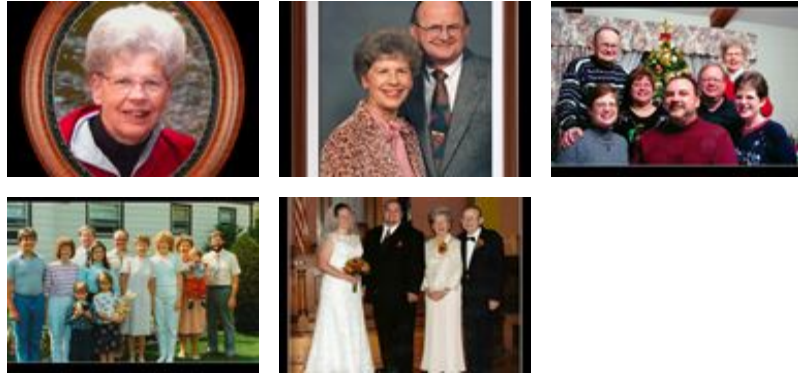
