Amy Lou "Amylou" Davis, 80, of Lansing, MI, formerly of Lacy Lake, died Tuesday, October 15, 2013. Mrs. Davis was born January 19, 1933, in East Lansing on the family farm on Coolidge Rd., the daughter of Gardner and Margaret (Herron) Coolidge. When her youngest child started school, she went back to work in the M.S.U. Physiology Department and became an indispensable member of the staff, retiring as the Undergraduate Coordinator after over 47 years. She met and married her husband, the love of her life, Gary Labadie, in 1986. She and Gary were active members of the Eagles. After her retirement, Amylou volunteered with her daughter at walk/runs for Susan B. Komen, Hospice, Michigan Mile, and at Sparrow Health Fairs. Amylou was known as a dedicated and responsible woman with a big heart who always took care of her loved ones. Above all, she loved her time spent with family. Amylou is survived by her children: Cindy (Steve) Grover of Eaton Rapids, Brian (Annette) Davis of Charlotte and Linda Davis of Lansing; her brother Dell E. (Linda) Coolidge, 7 grandchildren and 2 great-grandsons. She was predeceased by her husband, Gary Labadie, and by her grandson, Neil Grover.
