August 29, 1926 - November 15, 2015

Anna Mae (Royston) Conley, 89, died peacefully on Sunday, November 15, 2015 in Charlotte. She was born to Lester and Leeta (Parr) Royston on August 29, 1926. Anna Mae graduated from Charlotte High School, class of 1944, where she lettered in High School Band, and was the class secretary and high school student council secretary.

In 1945, she started working for Consumer's Power Company (now Consumer's Energy) and worked there for 25 years. In 1948, she married Elmer Conley. Together they had two children and were married nearly 52 years. They traveled the world every chance they had, and upon retirement wintered in San Benito, Texas for 12 years.

Anna Mae was a past member of Crossroads United Brethren Church and was financial secretary there for 25 years. She was a lifetime member of the Ladies Missionary group. Anna Mae was a member of the Olivet Senior Citizens, and a member and past president of South Side Mother's Club. She was also a past treasurer of Eaton County Extension, and a member and past president of Brookfield Extension Club. She was a life member of the Eaton Area Senior Center, and past board member and board secretary of Emerald Isle Condominium Association in Charlotte.

She lost her husband (Elmer) in 2000, a brother (Vernon Royston) in 2001,

and a sister (Elaine Gray) in 2004.

On January 30, 2004, she married Anthony (Tony) Jones of Decatur, Illinois. They also wintered in San Benito, TX for 11 years.

Survivors include her 2nd husband, Tony Jones of San Benito, TX; daughter, Sheri (Jerry) Sanders of Port Charlotte, FL; son Roger (Darlene) Conley of Charlotte; four grandchildren, Carmen (Brian) Charlton of Ormond Beach, FL; Chad (Christy) Sanders of Belleville, MI; Kristina Conley of Charlotte; Ryan Conley of Inverness, FL; five great-grandchildren, Emily, Grace, Natalie, Grant and Gavin; brother, Ernam Royston of Charlotte; sister Sharon (Lewie) Young of Charlotte; and many cousins, nieces, and nephews.
