Betty Lou (Moubray) Danford, 90, a wonderful daughter, sister, mother, grandmother, and friend, passed away December 2, 2019 at Eaton Community Palliative Care. Born October 25, 1929 in Lansing to Carlos and Hazel (Levis) Moubray, she attended Miller Road elementary in her early years and later graduated from Dimondale High School. 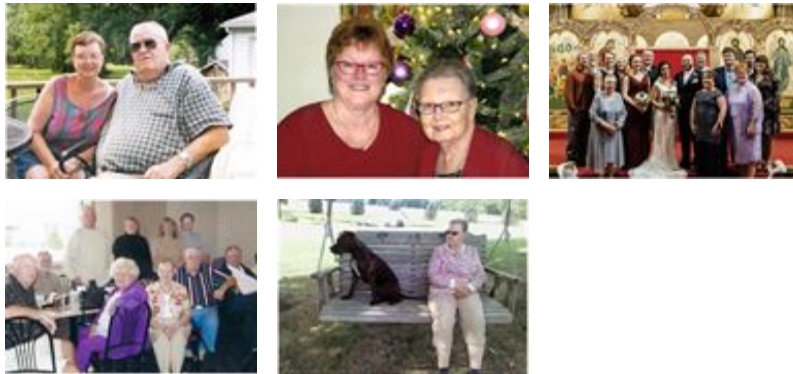
