Blake David Hamilton, 19, of Olivet, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, May 6, 2014. Blake was born July 8, 1994, in Lansing, the son of Gary and Lisa (Springs) Hamilton. Throughout his entire life, Blake loved the annual family camping trips. He attended Olivet High School, where he played football, sang in the choir, played the saxophone in the band and performed in the school musicals. Music was an important part of his life, especially the many years of piano lessons. He also participated in the choir and contemporary band at First Lutheran Church, where he was very active in the youth group. He also studied Tae Kwon Do, achieving his black belt. Blake loved skiing, on Duck Lake in the summer along with tubing, and on the slopes with ski club in the winter. Recently, he worked as the cook at Mike's Sports Page in Charlotte. Blake had a heart of gold, always willing to help anyone regardless of situation. He had an amazing smile, which he shared often, especially around children, who always loved him. Above all, Blake was a proud father to his 1 year old son, Liam.
