Bradley Earl (Brad) Brummette, age 70, of Charlotte, a strong-willed and outspoken man whose gruff exterior concealed a deeply caring heart, died unexpectedly on May 15, 2026. Brad was born November 13, 1955, in Charlotte, Michigan, the son of Doug and Lorna (Farr) Brummette.

Brad attended and graduated from Charlotte High School in the class of 1974. He was an exceptional athlete participating in both wrestling and football. On September 18, 1976, Brad married the love of his life, Dian Hisler. Together they shared nearly 50 years of marriage and built a life centered around family. They raised two sons and a daughter, all of whom Brad loved fiercely and was immensely proud of. Though he was not one to seek attention or stir up trouble, he would do absolutely anything for those he loved. He retired from General Motors, where he worked in the warehouse for many years.
