Carrol LeRoy Spicer, a true farmer and loving brother, passed away peacefully surrounded by his family on Friday, October 17, 2025. Carrol, 80, of Bellevue, Michigan was born May 3, 1945 in Delta Township, Eaton County, Michigan to Albert Dewey Spicer and Virginia Ida (Huffman) Spicer.

The fourth of nine children, Carrol was raised in a large family. As a child, Carrol attended Wetmore Country School, and later, Charlotte Public Schools. Upon graduating high school, Carrol enlisted in the United States Army and was stationed in Korea.
