



## Charles Allison Bracy

May 24, 1915 - January 29, 2013

Charles Allison Bracy, 97, of Charlotte, passed away on January 29, 2013. Charles was born on May 24, 1915, in Charlotte, the son of Leon and Ree (Love) Bracy. He graduated from Charlotte High School and farmed on the family farm and neighbors' farms. On November 29, 1941, he married his childhood sweetheart, Mary Roberts. A week later, he was called to serve his country overseas. Upon his return, Charles continued working as a farmer and, later, for Farm Bureau Co-op. He loved the outdoors, particularly camping, hunting and fishing with his family and friends, a love he passed on to his grandchildren. Charles was a member of the Ainger Bible Church of Olivet, where he served as Sunday school teacher and Deacon. Charles is survived by 3 Daughters: Charlene (Richard) Kenney of Bellevue, MI, Bonnie (David) Turley of Decatur, MI, Ruth (Clayton) Whipple of Charlotte, MI; 9 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife Mary on July 11, 1988, and siblings Leslie Bracy, Dortha Satterlee, Lana Crilly, Frank Bracy, Ed Bracy, Ellis Bracy and Rolland Bracy. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, February 2, 2013, at the Ainger Bible Church, Olivet, MI, with Pastor Scott Brood officiating. Burial will take place in West Carmel Cemetery.
