Charles "Chuck" Lee Case, 63, of Charlotte, a fun-loving bear of a man, died peacefully after a brief struggle with ALS on Wednesday, November 13, 2024. Chuck was born June 20, 1961 in Lansing, the son of Ronald Charles and Lois Louise (Garner) Case. He earned his diploma from Holt High School before going to work for Spartan Motors in Charlotte, where he served over 37 years, retiring as team leader of the body shop. Chuck enjoyed time spent in the outdoors, especially golfing, hunting for pheasant and deer, and tending his garden at home. His family will remember Chuck as a playful and loving father, grandfather, and "fun uncle." His trademark silver beard led to many young children to believe he was Santa Clause, a trait he enjoyed with a smile and twinkle in his eye.
