Cindy Jane Dymond, 77, an avid gardener with an affinity for irises, passed away July 16, 2022 at her home. Cindy was born on November 17, 1944 to Alpha and Ruth (Waak) Dymond. Flowers were her passion, including gladiolas, petunias, tulips, lilies, and the "pink dymond," a custom Iris that her father had cross-pollinated.

She was a member of the Michigan Iris Society where she often competed amongst her peers. She was also known to enter her flower arrangements in competition at the local Eaton County 4-H Fair. As a very particular, independent, and strong person her tenacious personality would help her throughout her life. Cindy was most proud of her daughter Faith Leigh and was nearly devastated by her loss in 1990. She worked as a secretary at American Bank & Trust, and later at MSU and LCC, and after retirement from those positions became a cashier at Meijer. A history and genealogy buff, she loved learning about her family tree. Cindy had a real knack for wrapping the perfect package. With a camera in her hand, Cindy caught, developed and created beautiful albums for us all to look through. Astrology was another passion of Cindy's, charting the horoscope of family members and often calling them to tell them when it would be a good time or bad to do certain activities.

Cindy is survived by her siblings, Diane Dymond, Crystal Noecker, Garry

Dymond, and Grace (Jeff) Ueberroth. She was predeceased by her daughter, Faith Leigh.

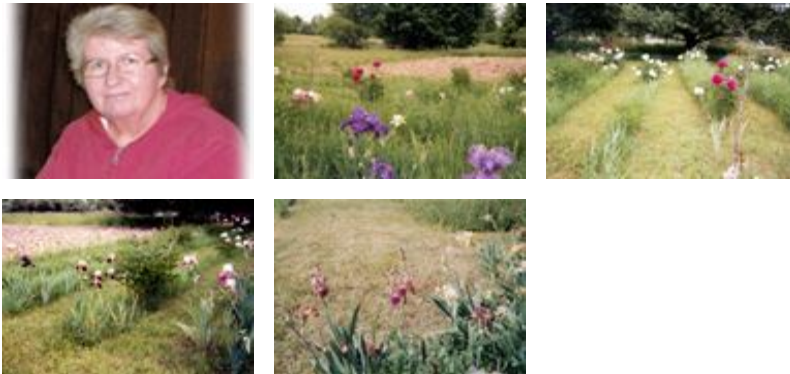
