Cynthia "Cindy" Sue Burns, a God-fearing woman, went to be with the Lord on Monday, December 16, 2024 after a courageous battle with cancer. 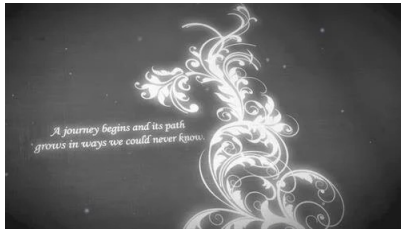

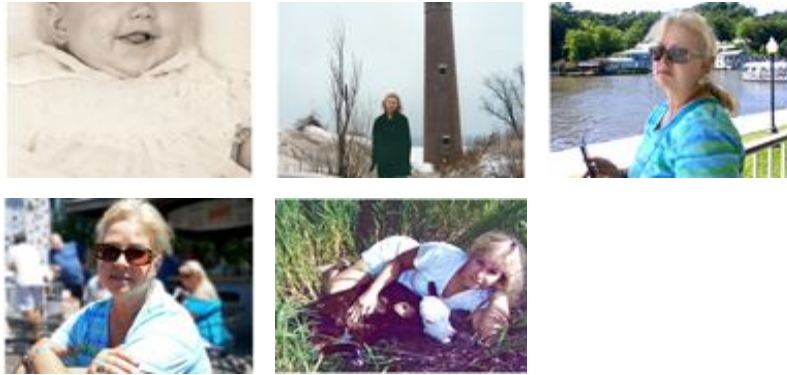
