Dagmar Streeter died Wednesday, January 18, 2012, in Charlotte. She was born in Grand Rapids, the daughter of Stanley and Dagmar (Findsen) Kucera. Many will remember Dagmar as the Branch Manager of Michigan National Bank. She spent 7 years at the Potterville Branch, and 11 in Charlotte, retiring in 1984. She also worked for Michigan Bell Telephone Co. and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers. Dagmar was a dedicated Hayes Green Beach Hospital Volunteer, a Life Member of the Order of the Eastern Star Charlotte Chapter 218, and Past President of the Charlotte Business Women's Guild. In her earlier years, she accomplished 13 years of perfect attendance in her school days. She was also a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Lansing. She is survived by several nieces and nephews and close friends. She is predeceased by her husband Howard Forest Streeter in 1997; sisters Yvonne J. Boyer and Samantha D. Brown; and her parents. Funeral services will be held 1:00 PM, Saturday, January 21, 2012, at Pray Funeral Home, Charlotte, with Reverend Rich Mitterling officiating. The family will receive visitors from 11:00-1:00 prior to the service on Saturday. Burial will be in Woodlawn Cemetery in Grand Rapids on Monday.
