David E Huber, Jr., 80, of Charlotte, joined his wife of 55 years Mary Ann Huber who died September 28th 2015. David's unexpected death was a result of a freak accident in the woods behind his home Sunday, November 1, 2015. He was born on September 15, 1935 to his parents David C. Huber and Francis L (Huff) Huber in Saginaw, MI.

David proudly joined the Army in April of 1957 serving his beloved country for two years. The future Mr. and Mrs. Huber met at the Brockway Roller Rink in Saginaw. On April 23, 1960 David and Mary were married at the Frankentrost Immanuel Lutheran Church 55 years ago and enjoyed living in the Frankentrost area, then moved to the Charlotte area in 1984.

David worked as a skilled tradesman for Oldsmobile. He also was a talented and capable carpenter. He loved working with wood and specialized in making cabinets and carving wooden horses for carousels. He built their family homes where they lived for many years. He also enjoyed cooking and baking cookies. Many will remember David from many local parades and car shows where he displayed his 1899 Curved Dash Oldsmobile replica, and more recently his 1903 Oldsmobile pie wagon both of which he built from scratch.

David was always in his element as he would help others with his many skills

and gifts. Even in his death he was able to help others through Gift of Life.

David had numerous affiliations from his many interests and skills. He was a member of USPS Power Squadron as a commander in the Saginaw Bay Area. He was also a Chaplin and said the prayers at their meetings and meals. He enjoyed his membership in the Wood Carvers of Greater Lansing and the Wood Worker Wood Guild. He also belonged to the Good Sam's RV Club. David was a member of the First Lutheran Church, and Laborers For Christ which built churches and schools in many cities throughout the U.S.

David is survived by his four daughters, Tammy Huber of Saginaw, Tina Huber of Atlanta, GA, Dawn (Craig) Wright of Charlotte; Michelle (Barry) Goff of Charlotte; grandchildren, Benjamin Hatheway, Amanda (EJ) Kasper, Derek Hatheway, Grant Goff and Paige Goff; his siblings Barbara (Fred) Head of Frankenmuth; Shirley (Vern) Yeomans of Saginaw; George (Sandy) Huber, of Saginaw. David is preceded in death by his wife Mary Ann; his brother-in-laws Fred Head of Frankenmuth; and Vern Yeomans of Saginaw.
