Donna Jean (King) Reed, 83, beloved mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, passed peacefully on January 3, 2019 at Sensations Memory Care. Born July 14, 1935 in Charlotte to Lester and Winifred (Carter) King, Donna grew up and always lived in the Charlotte/Olivet area. She graduated from Olivet High School in 1953 as the class valedictorian, and later from Lansing Business University graduated Suma Cum Laude in 1954. Donna worked for Auto Owners Insurance 1954-1958, and later as an executive secretary in the Department of Social Services at the State of Michigan from 1975 until her retirement in 2000. In her spare time, Donna enjoyed doing crossword puzzles, attending musicals and plays, was a book club member, and loved swimming at the Aquatic Center adult swim. She was proud to be the last surviving member of the Northside Mother's Club. Donna and her husband, Roger, enjoyed winter in Texas on South Padre Island.

Donna is survived by her husband of 60 years, Roger Reed; sons, Douglas and Terry Reed; daughter, Janice (Michael) Matsumoto; grandchildren, Alexis Reed, Samantha and Kimberely Matsumoto; 1 great-grandchild; and sister, Leah Sparks. She was predeceased by siblings, Doris Andrus and Mary Fullerton, and her parents.

“ I have very fond memories of Donna. In 1985, I arrived one day on her doorstep; the result of a leadership change in the Medicaid program. I was immediately struck by her warmth and her honesty. This was an abrupt change and Donna was very clear about her respect and admiration for my predecessor. She was also very clear that a change had been made and she would do her level best to support me, if I wanted her to continue as my secretary. I knew immediately that I wanted her to stay; mainly because of our prior interactions and her stellar reputation throughout State government.

She never wavered from her commitment to be supportive and helpful as I transitioned over to Medicaid. I quickly came to rely upon her. Somehow, she always managed to find a needed document in her file room, even though the files appeared to everyone, except Donna, to be cluttered and out of control. She was also masterful in handling incoming phone calls; knowing exactly what department could best satisfy an inquiry, or helping an irate citizen, or delicately handling legislative or press inquiries.

Donna was a very smart and talented individual. She understood fully the policies of Medicaid and the people and the organizational structure of the surrounding bureaucracy. She also had a great sense of humor. I remember taking Maria's limo to El Azteco with Donna and Don VeCasey occupying the rumble seat. I also remember the gong show, holiday parties and birthday celebrations. Each special event had her imprint as she helped shape and monitor to make sure that there was a positive impact on staff morale.

I have not seen Donna in a number of year. But, she is one of the few people who keep recurring in my memories. I will always treasure her friendship and remain eternally grateful for her support over the years. To put it simply - she was the best secretary that I every had the pleasure of working with.

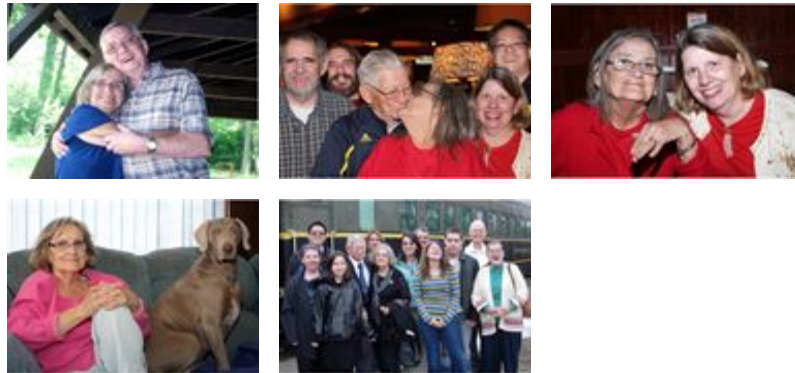
