



## Douglas D Mohre

December 19, 1947 - January 16, 2017

Douglas Dean Mohre, 69, of Charlotte, passed away peacefully in his sleep after a brief illness on January 16, 2017 in Charlotte, MI. He was born on December 19, 1947 to Donald and Thelma (Pifer) Mohre in Lansing, MI. He served his country during the Vietnam war. While serving overseas he became a University of Michigan Football fan listening to the games broadcast over international radio. After returning state side he continued as a fan attending the U of M football games.

Douglas worked as a Master Electrician at the State Secondary Complex for State of Michigan, and later working at IBEW. Douglas loved gardening, planting anything that he could eat. Hunting and fishing were his two favorite pastimes. Some of his favorite memories were family trips to deer camp over the many years. Doug had the ability to fix or repair just about anything. His ability to look at a problem and figure out how to fix it was a unique talent he exhibited. His knowledge and ability was something he enjoyed sharing with his younger co-workers. Doug was one of those who was a "dad" to everybody. In addition to raising his boys, Doug was a father figure to his two nephews Ben and Brandon Youngs and many others.

Douglas is survived by his three sons, Tim Mohre; Andrew Mohre of Taylors, SC; and Jason (Amy) Mohre; two grandsons, Tyler and Wyatt; granddaughter, Ava; fiancé, Cherry Jenkins; sister, Maxine Rach; and brother, Leonard Mohre.

He was preceded in death by father, Donald Mohre, mother, Thelma Mohre.

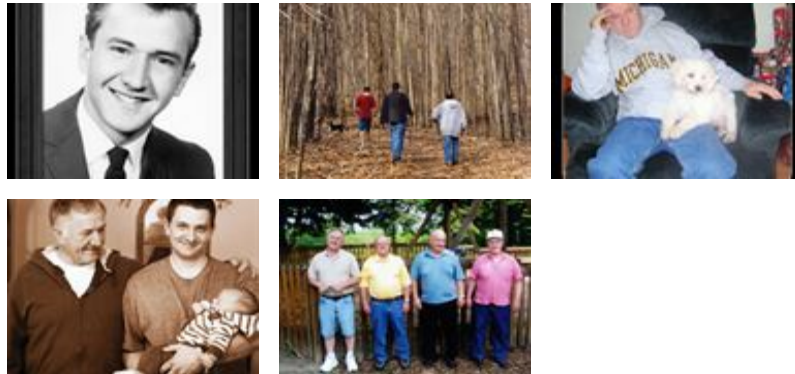
