



Edgar Allen Fremody

July 27, 1922 - May 5, 2014

Edgar Allen Fremody, 91, of Charlotte passed away on Monday, May 5 after a lengthy illness. He was born July 27, 1922 in Lansing, MI to C. Edgar and Hildred (Allen) Fremody. He was a graduate of Potterville High School and during those years he led a dance band reflecting the Glenn Miller music style. Ed served as a Pharmacist's Mate with the U.S. Navy during World War II and was attached to the Third Marine Division in the South Pacific. He married June Saums in February of 1948, and they had two children. Ed retired from the U.S. Postal Service after 31 ½ years of service in January 1980. He was a 22 year volunteer for the Charlotte Fire Department, was an active member of the Lawrence Avenue United Methodist Church, a Chancel Choir member for many years, a lifetime member of the Greenawalt Flaherty American Legion Post #42, and the Elks Lodge #3113 in Lansing, MI. He had been a volunteer for Mobil Meals. Throughout the years he enjoyed music, traveling, golf, fishing, woodworking, and most of all being "Grandpa."

Ed is survived by his wife of 66 years, June, daughter Lori (David) Brown of Charlotte, granddaughter Heather (William Cruz) Brown of Grand Ledge, grandson Tory Brown of Farmington MI, great-grandson William Carter Cruz, niece Joan (David) Brown of Omena, and nephews Steve Hartel of Lansing, Lance (Micki) Hartel of Diamond Bar, CA, and Ron Saums of Columbia, MO. He was preceded in death by his parents, son David Jon Fremody in 1992, sister Marthadawn Hartel Hustwick, nephew Brad Hartel and niece Lois Smith.
