Eugenia “Genie” Burke Wilmore, 97, of Grand Ledge, died peacefully on Monday, February 13, 2017 in Charlotte. Genie was born April 3, 1919, in Scobey, Montana, the daughter of Patrick and Mary (Laux) Burke. In her youth, she enjoyed riding horses and singing in the local church choir. She graduated from Butte High School in Butte, Montana and attended one year of college before enlisting in the Army Air Force.
