Everett "Clem" Brangenberg, 90, of Charlotte, Michigan, died at his home after a battle with Parkinson's Disease, with his family by his side. He was born in Alton, Illinois, September 26, 1925, to Val and Thelma (Elledge) Brangenberg.

Mr. Brangenberg graduated from Alton High School. He married the "love of his life", Shirley (Oller) Brangenberg on June 3, 1960, and they were married 55 years. Mr. Brangenberg began working for Owens Illinois Glass Company as a mold maker before transferring to the Charlotte plant in 1963; he retired after 44 years of service. He coached little league baseball for many years, loved his home and working in his yard. He was a life member of the Grand Ledge Masons of Michigan.

He was predeceased by his parents, and sister, Rosemary Walker.
