Floyd M. Jewell, 72, of Charlotte, MI died Friday, May 16, 2008. Mr. Jewell was born November 9, 1935 in Olivet, MI the son of Jeremiah and Flora (Bealefeld) Jewell. Mr. Jewell retired as President from the Eaton Federal Savings Bank on August 31, 2005 after 44 years of service. As president of the bank, Mr. Jewell was instrumental in helping the Charlotte community in many ways. Mr. Jewell served in the Navy where he was a photographer. He was a member of the Lawrence Avenue United Methodist Church, Rotary, Chamber of Commerce, Masons, Shriners, Yacht Club and the Jaycees. Mr. Jewell was past president of the Michigan League of Community Banks, on the Hayes Green Beach Board and participated in Frontier Days. He enjoyed caring for his property, golf, bowling, jogging, tinkering around the house, U of M sports and the outdoors. He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Sally; sons Timothy (Diana) Jewell and Thomas (Sandy) Jewell; 2 grandchildren, Lauren and Lacy Mae; brother, Gideon Jewell and sister, Lucy Howard.
