George Edward Fullerton, 98, of Charlotte, died peacefully on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 at home. George was born on a farm in Charlotte on September 9, 1919, the son of Delbert and Gertrude (Hines) Fullerton. He graduated from Charlotte High School in 1938 before devoting his lifetime to the family farm. George actively supported local 4H, serving as a judge at the fair and teaching gun safety. He also raised deer and worked closely with law enforcement to rehabilitate injured deer. Many friends will remember learning woodworking from George on the farm and seeing him daily at Willy's Restaurant. He was an original founder of the Michigan Bird and Game Breeders Association, a member of Pheasants Forever and attended countless events throughout the years. George will be missed by countless close friends and family.

George is survived by his daughters, Barbara Fullerton and Linda Hinds; 4 grandchildren, Dawn (Pete) Hundt, Tammy Washburn, Afton (Aaron) Bailey and Ashley Fullerton; 8 great-grandchildren; 2 great-great-grandchildren; and close friends, Bob Donely and Joe Gooch. He is predeceased by his son, Roger Fullerton and his brothers, Robert Fullerton and Clarence Fullerton.

Funeral services will be at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 1, 2017 at Pray Funeral Home with Pastor Charles Jenson officiating. Visitation will be on Tuesday, October 31, 2017 from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. at the funeral home.

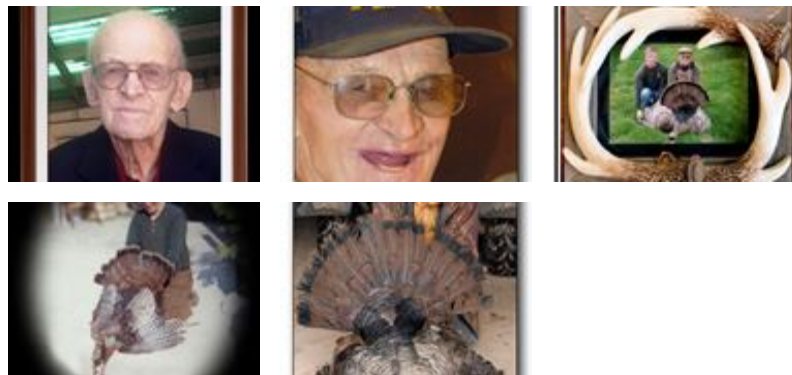

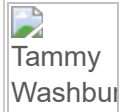

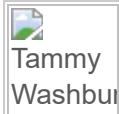
