Henry Moore, 90, died peacefully at his home in Clermont, FL on Friday evening, November 15, 2013.

Henry began his career at H. F. Moore and Son, founded by his father, Harry Moore. He assumed ownership of the family business in 1963 which was regarded as the area's premier general construction company. Following Henry's retirement, he relocated to Clermont, FL where he spent many happy years at Disney as the conductor of the Main Street Train and the driver of the Main Street Fire Truck. Henry was a member of the Charlotte Masonic Lodge and received his 50 year pin this year. An avid hunter, Henry died on the first day of hunting season and spent many active seasons at his camp in Ocqueoc, MI with friends and family. An avid Nascar fan, Henry had the names of top drivers and their records at his fingertips and rooted for Tony Stewart.
