James "Jim" David Rogers, a kind hearted man, died unexpectedly on Sunday, October 1, 2023. Jim 55, of Charlotte, was born January 23, 1968, in Hinsdale, IL., the son of Lloyd and Catherine (Stahl) Rogers. After graduating from high school Jim went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Teaching from Illinois State University. For the last 19 years he has worked for Farm Bureau Insurance.
