Jane Weaver, 88, of Charlotte, died peacefully on Sunday, September 22, 2019 at her residence at Hope Landing. Jane was born March 30, 1931 in Benton Twp., the daughter of Robert C. and Dorothy Alleen (Kingman) Weaver. She graduated from Charlotte High School in 1948 before attending Western Michigan University and earning her Teaching Certificate. Jane lived over 50 years in Texas, where she worked in beauty and skin care. She retired from Natura Bisse in 2007 at the age of 77. Jane loved to travel and enjoyed the big city lights but never forgot her farm girl roots. After her return to Michigan in 2008 Jane made Hope Landing her home.
