Jerrold "Jerry" Raymond DeMuth was a kind, yet stubborn man with a huge heart. He died May 29, 2025 at the age of 76. Jerry was born in and lived his entire life in Charlotte, MI, the son of Carl and Barbara (Nisse) DeMuth. He attended Potterville Schools until the 12th grade, he graduated from Charlotte in 1967. After high school he started working at Oldsmobile, where he worked for 32 years before his retirement in June of 2000. After retirement Jerry and his wife Linda enjoyed wintering in Arizona.
