December 9, 1921 - March 31, 2017

June Eileen Fremody, 95, passed away March 31, 2017, in Charlotte, Michigan. She was born December 9, 1921, to Glen Bernon and Ida Orrie (Baisel) Saums, in Eaton County. June graduated from Charlotte High School, and lived in Charlotte for all of her life. She worked for many years as an executive secretary, filling positions at the Eaton County School Commissioner's Office, the Probate Office, Wilcox-Gay Corporation, and Aluminum Extrusions, Inc. June retired from the Charlotte Public School system in 1982, after 14 years.

June was a dedicated member of the Lawrence Avenue United Methodist Church for 75 years, and served in a variety of offices. She directed choirs for the church for ten years, and was a long time member of the chancel choir; she was a faithful member of the United Methodist Women and the Deborah Circle. She not only served in her church, but found many areas outside the church to volunteer and serve others, including the Eaton County Association of Retired School personnel, the American Legion Auxiliary, the Eaton Area Senior Center, Hayes Green Beach Hospital Auxiliary, and the Gift Basket.

June loved music. Her family said, "After church and family, her love of music was the most important thing in her life." This was clearly seen in her years of singing as a member of the Chancel Choir, at numerous weddings and at community functions. June also loved the game of golf, and played well into

her eighties, which her family all admired.

June is survived by her daughter, Lori June (David) Brown; two grandchildren, Heather June Brown (Bill Cruz) and Tory David Brown, who were both the light of her life; great-grandchildren, Gabriela Cruz and William Carter Cruz; a dear niece, Joan (David) Brown of Traverse City, MI; nephews, Ronald Saums of Columbia, MO, Steven Hartel, and Lance (Mickie) Hartel, of Diamond Bar, CA.; and several great nieces and nephews. June was preceded in death by her husband, Edgar (Ed) Fremody; son, David Jon Fremody, in 1992; parents, Glen and Ida Saums; sister, Bernadene (Saums) Marshall; two brothers, Max Saums, and Howard Saums; and niece Lois Smith.

Funeral services will be at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 5, 2017 at Lawrence Avenue United Methodist Church, Charlotte, MI, with Pastor Lyle Robinette officiating. Visitation will be held Tuesday, April 4, 2017, from 2:00-4:00 p.m. and 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Pray Funeral Home, and on Wednesday, at the church, from 10:00-11:00 a.m., prior to the funeral service.
