Kenneth Paul Stults II, 56, fondly known as KP to all who knew and loved him, passed away on August 27, 2025, with his daughter by his side. 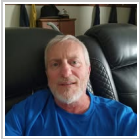

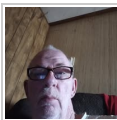

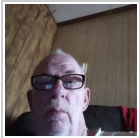
