sought out the spiciest, hottest dishes and added even more hot sauce, just to prove his mettle.

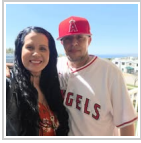
Every conversation with Kent concluded with the words, "I love you," a testament to the deep affection he held for his family.
