Kim Edward Geyer, a man who had a great heart for people and often extended help to strangers, died on Tuesday, November 26, 2024. Kim, 62, of Dimondale, was born on December 26, 1961, in Lansing, the son of Robert and Maryellen (Wickham) Geyer. He earned a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology from Michigan State University. Kim retired from MSU as an Electronics Technician. He later worked for Block Imaging as a Component Repair Technician. Kim was a lifelong learner and a jack of all trades, if he did not know how to do something he would attend courses at LCC to learn how to fix it. Kim was an avid outdoorsman, he loved canoeing, camping, and fishing. Most recently he and his wife Karin went on a UP camping trip, and together enjoyed their breakfast alongside Lake Superior. Traveling was a big part of his life, he enjoyed exploring ghost and old towns, and taking in the sites. He also enjoyed playing his guitar and reading Christian and Presidential books. Kim devoted his life to the Lord; he had a strong knowledge of the bible. Along with traveling he also had a passion for golfing. In his younger years he was a great golfer and won several trophies. Above all Kim wants to be remembered for his love for his family.

Kim is survived by his loving wife, Karin; children, Jason Lees, Michael Lees, and Rachel (Michael) Schmidt; grandchildren, Jonas Schmidt, and Nora Schmidt; sister, Valerie Geyer; and father, Robert Geyer. He was predeceased by his mother, Maryellen Geyer.

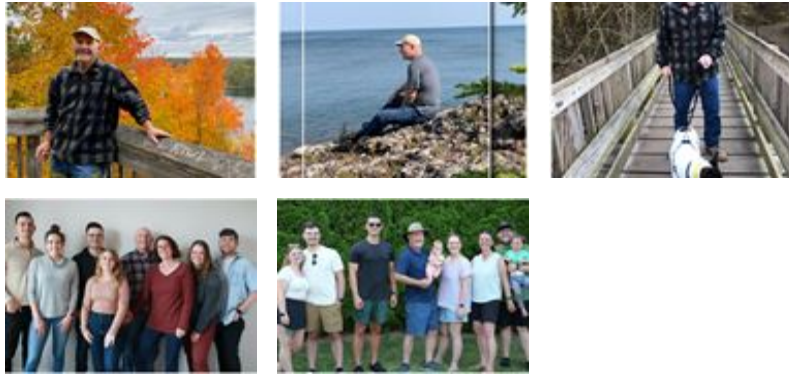
