Kristy Kay Ullman, 64, of Charlotte, a loving mother, grandmother, sister, friend, and advocate for those in need, died peacefully on Wednesday, January 8, 2025. Kristy was born April 24, 1960 in Lansing, the daughter of Lynn Brook and Lois Kay (Root) Bowerman. She graduated from Olivet High School before settling into family life and raising her two beloved children. Kristy's siblings will remember their older sister as a loving caretaker, both of her own children, and her younger siblings. She had a very special place in her heart for babies and young children, and would also cuddle and hold them. Throughout her life, Kristy was also a rescuer. Above all, Kristy's legacy will be her family.

Kristy is survived by her daughter, Nicole Ullman; son, Christopher Ullman; grandchildren, Sabrina and Bethany Bowerman, Alex Koteles, and Aria LoPresti; siblings, Jeffrey (Shelly) Bowerman, Kelly (Lee) Koteles, and Justin (Michelle) Bowerman; and numerous nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her husband, James Arthur Ullman; daughter, Kerrolyn Scardo; her parents; and her nephew, Adam Vorce.
