Laura W. Thoman, 89, of Grand Ledge, MI died Tuesday, December 14, 2010. Mrs. Thoman was born May 5, 1921 in Atlanta, GA the daughter of Luther D. and Bessie (Callaway) Elliott. Mrs. Thoman married Joseph E. Thoman on February 20, 1945 in Paris, France where they both served in the armed forces in WWII. He preceded her in death March 13, 1998. Mrs. Thoman was employed by Springfield, IL School Board as Office Secretary at Jefferson Jr. High from 1957-1967. She worked for Kane County Circuit Court in Geneva, IL serving as Deputy Court Clerk from 1971 until she retired to Florida in 1976. Mrs. Thoman was a Women's Army Corp (US Army) veteran; a member and past commander of the former Mary Todd American Legion Post 999 in Springfield, IL and a member and past treasurer of WAC Veterans Chapter 78, in Crystal River, FL. While she was in Florida, she was a member of Crystal River United Methodist Church. She is survived by her daughter, Constance M. (Tom) Taylor of Charlotte; son, William E. (Kathy) Thoman of Plainfield, IL; 7 grandchildren; two great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, Joseph Thoman and sister, Jane Ebner.
