April 27, 1921 - October 3, 2016

Leora "Jean" Scutt, 95, of Potterville, MI, died peacefully on Monday, October 3, 2016 in Grand Ledge. Jean was born April 27, 1921, in Kalamazoo, the daughter of Merle J. and Leila Caroline (Coleman) Branch. She graduated from Bellevue High School in 1939 and married Earl Scutt on August 22, 1942. Together they settled in Potterville, where they lived 65 years. Jean worked as the Elementary Secretary for the Potterville Schools, retiring in 1983. She and Earl enjoyed traveling, dancing, singing, golf, and, above all, time spent with family and friends. They were also longtime active members of Potterville United Methodist Church, where they both sang in the choir. Jean participated in many community activities throughout the years.

She is survived by her daughter, Janet (James) Tinkey of Potterville; son, David (Debra) Scutt of Mason; 9 grandchildren and step-grandchildren; and 17 great-grandchildren. She was predeceased by her husband of 67 years, Earl August Scutt; sisters, Dorothy and Lois; brother, Gordon; and her parents.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, October 7, 2016 at Potterville United Methodist Church with Rev. Tom Fox officiating. Visitation will be from 10:00 - 11:00 a.m. on Friday, October 7, 2016, at the church, just prior to the service. Interment for both Earl and Jean will take place in Benton Twp. Cemetery. 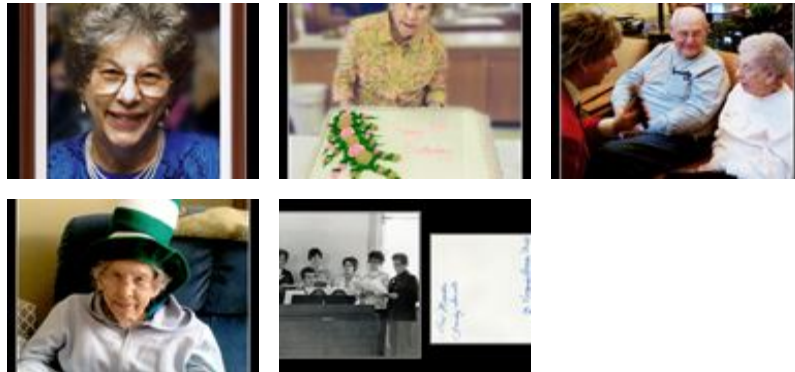
