Lisa Marie (Cicinelli) Fox, 52, of Charlotte, died peacefully on Saturday, June 20, 2015. Lisa was born February 24, 1963 in Detroit, MI, the daughter of Vito Joseph and Rose (Prano) Cicinelli. The family moved to Lansing, where Lisa graduated from Sexton High School in 1981. She worked for Lansing General Hospital before settling in Charlotte, where she began her career with Hayes Green Beach Hospital. She worked nearly 20 years for HGB. She served as Director of Revenue Cycle until she was no longer able to do so. Lisa was a very community minded person, always volunteering her time. She enjoyed time with friends each week and evenings with her mother and grandmother. Lisa was a BIG MSU fan, especially during football season. Above all, she loved her family.

Lisa is survived by her husband of 12 years, James Fox; daughters, Janelle (Nick) Crocket, Ashley (fiance Eric Bailey) Fox and Brooke Fox; son, Jimmy Fox; grandchildren, Talan, Keegan and Colton; parents, Vito and Rose Cicinelli; sister, Laurie (Matt) Kulhanek; brother, Joseph (Kelli) Cicinelli; nephew, Vito Cicinelli; and nieces, Madison Bradley, Sarah and Laura Kulhanek.
