January 23, 1934 - November 26, 2023

Lois Elaine Bartholomew, 89, of Charlotte, a woman full of fierce love for her family, died Sunday, November 26, 2023 in Grand Ledge surrounded by her children and grandchildren. Lois was born January 23, 1934 in Lake Odessa, the daughter of Wilber and Margaret (Mesecar) Dye. She graduated from Lakewood High School and went to work making fishing rods at Action Rod in Hastings, MI. She and her lifelong love, Melvin Bartholomew, married in 1958 upon his return from serving in the Navy during the Korean Conflict. Lois settled happily into family life, raising their daughters, and hosting family holidays. She was a renowned baker and cook, especially known for her beef and noodles and her special raised, glazed donuts. Lois was also very artistic, and painted many beautiful pieces, as well as quilting, crafting, and expressing her creativity through floral arranging. She also made lampshades, stenciled items, canvas prints, and many other beautiful expressions of art she shared with all who knew her. The most important part of Lois' life was her family. She attended most all of her grandchildren's sporting events, where she was known to loudly support her family. Lois enjoyed trips up north to Ford Lake and Lake Charlevoix with her family, and visiting friends and family. Many will remember her spunky charm and feisty independence. Her sarcastic form of humor remained intact to the end, even despite her Alzheimer's. Her family will miss her dearly, but feel blessed for the time they spent with her these last few years.

Lois is survived by her daughters, Jill (Jim) Wright and Lori (Steve) Orler; 3 grandchildren, Jamie Wright, Kelsey Wright, and Maddie Orler, 2 great-grandchildren, Kohen and Ezra Bristor; and brother, Larry (Barbara) Dye of Lake Odessa. She was predeceased by her husband of 62 years, Melvin in 2020; and her brother, Dallas Dye in 1981.
