Lucille May (Whiting,er,) Tuckey, 77, died Tuesday, July 10, 2012. Lucille was born on November 18, 1934, to Elwood and Eunice Whiting,er in Charlotte, Michigan. She was a gifted pianist and performer from the age of three until her final public concert on March 17, 2012. She was drawn to the sounds of Bach, Debussy and Chopin and later discovered Broadway tunes and other legendary musicians as she developed her musical style. Lucille was a long-time member of the Charlotte Rotary club playing piano for membership sing-alongs. She also accompanied many local musicians for CHS band solo competitions. For numerous years, she was the organist and music director for the St. Johns Episcopal Church. She taught countless students to play piano and guitar in addition to playing for many weddings, funerals, and other community musical and dance programs. Lucille was also actively involved in the local arts community for many years as an artist.

She was preceded in death by her son Daniel Tuckey, her parents, and sister, Marion Whiting,er. She is survived by her children; Brian (Ronda) Tuckey, Sue Tuckey, Sara (Max) Powers, Chris Tuckey Volz, Julie Wertz, Steve Tuckey, Robert Tuckey, and Edward (Carole) Tuckey; and her siblings Wilma Campbell, Leila Whiting,er, Linda (Matt) Silvas, and John (Sue) Whiting,er. She is also survived by thirteen grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

Lucille will be remembered for her love of family, children, grandchildren and

great grandchildren, as well as for her willingness to share her talents with others. A celebration of her life will be held at 2:00 pm Saturday, July 14, 2012 at the First Congregational Church of Charlotte with Pastor Phil Hobson and Pastor Jack Brown officiating.
