Lynn Wesley Burt, of Charlotte passed away after a short battle with cancer on September 28, 2016. Lynn was born to his parents Leo and Jeane (Hillis) Burt February 26, 1953 in Charlotte, MI. After graduation from Charlotte High School in 1973 he worked as a skilled tradesman for several different manufacturing companies in the greater Lansing area, retiring from General Motors in 2014.

Lynn's family and friends will remember him as devoted grandfather who was happy to lead a simple life. He never missed his grandchildren's sporting events or band concerts, sometimes showing up long before they began. His family remembers his love of racing, whether it was on the dirt track or the big oval. His other favorite interests were tinkering and traveling the roads on his Harley, and picking a bluegrass tune on his banjo.
