Margaret Anna Sheehan, 94, of Charlotte, formerly of Gladwin, MI, passed away peacefully on July 15, 2016 at her home in Charlotte, MI. She was born on February 20, 1922 to Ernest and Anna Hewitt in Bay City, MI.

Margaret attended the Gerrish-Higgins High School in Roscommon, graduating as the Valedictorian of her class of 1939. She went on to Mercy Nursing School in Bay City, MI and St. Mary's in Grand Rapids, MI graduating as a Registered Nurse in 1942. Margaret then joined the US Army Nurse Corps during World War II serving in the Philippines and New Guinea. She later returned to nursing, serving many years as an ER nurse at Gladwin, MI county hospital.

Margaret is survived by her eight sons, Timothy M.(Colleen) Sheehan of Charlotte, MI, Matthew E. (MaryPat) Sheehan of East Tawas, MI, Joseph G. Anderson), and son Martin Sheehan.
