Marville Anna Frith, 101, a devoted wife, mother and grandmother, died peacefully on Saturday, November 16, 2019 at Flower House of Nashville. Marville, formerly of Vermontville, was born July 16, 1918 in Morris, IL, the daughter of Andrew Elmer and Anna Marie (Olsen) Lindberg. She graduated high school in Vermontville before earning a Bachelor's degree from Western State Teachers College. She taught at Eaton County Country Schools, including the Brown School, Nickle School, and Thornton School, then in Grand Ledge Public Schools. Marville married Lawrence A. Frith on July 23, 1944 at Jefferson Parish in New Orleans, LA. Following marriage, Marville settled in to raise their four children. She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, 4H throughout her lifetime, and Farm Bureau. She enjoyed sewing, gardening, genealogy, and reading. Marville also loved nature, and was always seeking to name the many birds and their songs she encountered. Marville's family will always carry her in their hearts.
