Max Eugene Potter, 82, of Charlotte, died February 18, 2015. He was born September 12, 1932 in Brookfield Twp., the son of Carl and Edith Mae (Xanders) Potter. Max grew up working on farms, first with his dad, then on his own. He worked 34 years at General Motors in Lansing, retiring from the Delta Plant. During this time he married Joyce May Hutchison, started a family, raised beef, and was active in his church. He and his wife felt impressed by the Lord to establish a campground on their farm where Christian people could come apart from the world for fellowship, preaching, and relaxation. Shady Green Pastures Bible Camp is now nearing its 50th anniversary and has hosted hundreds of missionaries and churches. Many will remember Max's sense of humor and hard-working spirit.

He is survived by his wife, Joyce (Hutchison) Potter; children, Mark (Susan) Potter, Julie (Ron) Porritt, Annette (Rick) Craft, Ruth (Scott) Haigh and Luke (Stacy) Potter; 20 grandchildren; 6 great-grandchildren; and brother, Ray (Joanne) Potter. He is predeceased by his other siblings.
