Michael Lee King, 69, of Charlotte, MI (formerly of Buckley, MI) passed away peacefully on Sunday, August 14, 2016 due to complication of exposure to Agent Orange in Vietnam. Michael was born in Lansing, MI on December 4, 1946 to Dwaine and June Rosalee (Small) King. After graduating from Holt High School he worked for the State of Michigan Health Department, before joining the Army and going to Vietnam from 1966-1968. He later worked for Oldsmobile and then General Motors until his retirement in 1998. Michael was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie #1039, and loved going to car shows with his 1989 Buick Reatta, attending auctions, playing scratch-off lottery tickets, and socializing and spending time with friends and family.

Michael is survived by his wife, Vicki King; daughter Shannin King; son Ryan (Jacque) King; granddaughters Anna King and Amelia Wood; and sister Beverly (Rudy) Tirban. He was preceded in death by his parents and brother Gerald King.

A memorial service is scheduled for Friday, August 19, 2016, 12 noon at Pray Funeral Home with Pastor Damon Milton officiating, with interment to follow at Eastlawn Cemetery in Okemos.
