Nancy Lee Cheeseman, 75, of Vermontville, Michigan, died Tuesday, February 7, 2012. Mrs. Cheeseman was born July 10, 1936, in Lansing, Michigan the daughter of J.D. and Hazel C. (Kimmel) Blackburn. Nancy was an accomplished musician playing steel guitar in her musical group for 15 years at events such as Governor Williams' Ball and in places including Soldiers' Field in Chicago. Nancy also played guitar and electric bass plus vocals for her husband's band for 20 years. Nancy was involved in various activities as one of Jehovah's Witnesses for over 55 years, remaining faithful in service up to the present time. She married Vance R Cheeseman in October of 1956 and they enjoyed over 55 years of marriage.
