Neil Eugene Howe, 65, of Grass Lake, died peacefully surrounded by family on Friday, December 8, 2017 at his home. 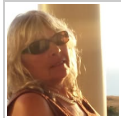

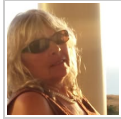
