



Norma Jean Shoup

March 26, 1937 - July 9, 2019

Norma Jean Shoup (Frazier), 82 of Charlotte, MI, an excellent cook that adored her family, died peacefully July 9, 2019 at her home surrounded by her family. Norma was born March 26, 1937 in Owosso to Howard and Virginia (Neuman) Frazier, and in 1955 graduated from Owosso High School. She married Robert Duane Shoup in January of 1957 and enjoyed raising their 5 children together, until her husband and two daughters (Victoria and Laura) were killed in a car accident in 1968. She married Don Shoup in 1969, and while Don had two children of his own, he and Norma together had two more children and their house was very full and bustling all the time.

Norma had many interests, including: time spent at the beach, ceramics, painting, canning, cooking, family outings on the 1st Sunday of every month, instrumental music, reading, making jewelry, and watching her hummingbirds. Her family lovingly said she was the "Queen Bee" of the Red Hat Society. Norma was an easy-going, strong and loving mother, and never complained about anything. She worked as a Real Estate Broker, Secretary for a Judge, and as a homemaker. She enjoyed wintering in Bradenton, Florida with her siblings, and was very proud of her family.

Norma was preceded in death by her 1st husband, Robert and 2nd husband Donald; children, Victoria, and Laura Shoup; step-son, Bruce Shoup; brother, John Frazier; sisters, Nancy Braithwaite, Mary Clase, and Irene Britton; and

her parents. Norma is survived by her children, Tami (George) Stickles, George (Colleen) Shoup, Robert (Deanna) Shoup, Paula (Jeff) Meaton; Donna (Douglas) Morse; step-daughter, Lynette (Brian) Robinson, step-daughter-in-law, Penny (Mark) Shoup-Noble; 20 grandchildren; 27 great-grandchildren; brother, Ted (Gwen) Frazier; sister-in-law, Geri Frazier; numerous nieces and nephews; and close friend, Carol Visser.

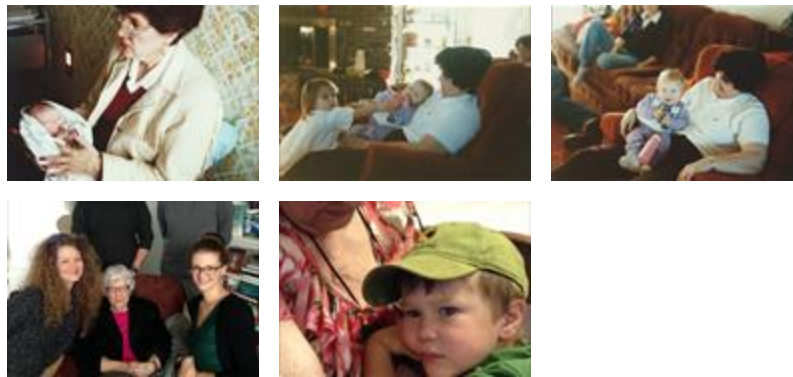

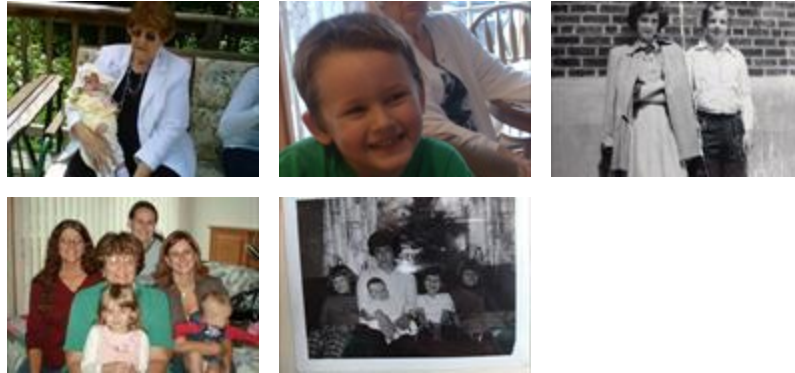
