Norman Lewis Watters, a man known for always being there to help those in need, died on Wednesday, August 17, 2022. Norman 84, of Potterville, was born on May 9, 1938, in his grandparent's farmhouse in Fowlerville, MI, the son of Lewis and Naomi (Phillips) Watters. He was one of 8 children so from an early age Norman gained a strong work ethic from working on his family's farm alongside his siblings. Norman proudly served in the Army and was stationed in Germany. Upon his discharge from the Army, Norman began working for Clayton Cline Fertilizer. Later he was known as a Jack-of-all-trades doing numerous handyman jobs for people. Several years back he moved to Michigan from Arkansas, where he settled into Potterville. Norman had a passion for music and enjoyed playing his guitar and banjo. He also enjoyed working on his vehicles, and fishing. In 2005 Norman married Elaine Hale and together they created lasting memories. The couple were members at the Calvary Grace Church in Eaton Rapids. Faith was a big part of Norman's life. Many will remember Norman for being a social butterfly who could strike up a conversation with anybody.

Norman is survived by his wife, Elaine; numerous children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren; siblings, Clara Binetti, Darlene Phillips, and Dennis Watters; and several extended family members. He was predeceased by his parents; siblings, Darwin Watters, Marvin Watters, James Watters, and Dale Watters.
