Patricia Langmaack, a selfless person, always full of love, died peacefully at the age of 88. After graduating from Olivet High school in 1952, Pat worked for Drs. Chapman and Britton in their Optometry office and then at Quentin Bosworth's Veterinary practice for many years. A 4-H volunteer for many years, Pat taught countless young people the skills of sewing and cooking, many of whom became "adopted" grandchildren.

Pat married Hans Langmaack in 1953 and the couple purchased their farm just three years later where they went on to raise their family and make countless memories. Ever devoted to her family, Pat was a wonderful mother, grandmother, and great grandmother who was often found caring for grandchildren and baking treats for all who visited. Hans and Pat enjoyed time with friends and family and spent many fun evenings visiting with friends at Thursday night "farmer's suppers."

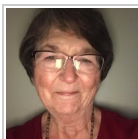
