Paul Ernest Evert, 73, of Charlotte, passed away on July 3, 2012 at Eaton Community Palliative Care from an unexpected medical condition. Paul was born on April 14, 1939 to Ray and Nina (Smith) Evert in Stockbridge, Michigan. He worked for A E Hoover Universal in Charlotte as an anodizing operator for 35 years until the company closed in 1988. He was a very loyal worker and never missed a day of work. He worked for several more years at Charlotte Anodizing and finally retired in 2002 . On December 24, 1960 Paul married Ella Mae Aseltine and together they raised one son and one daughter in Charlotte, MI. He was a member of the Calvary Baptist Church and enjoyed attending the men's Bible Study group every Tuesday. He and Ella helped with the flowers at the church. Paul loved nature, cats, chickens and birds. He enjoyed yard work and camping, and hunting for pudding stones. Paul is survived by his loving spouse of 51 years, Ella Mae; his son Frank (Rae Jane) Cortright of Olivet, daughter Nina June Evert of Charlotte, a special friend of the family, Carol Pruden of Charlotte; 3 brothers, Raymond (Sandy) Evert of Grand Ledge, Wayne Evert of Charlotte, and Eddie (Bonnie) Evert of Ionia; and brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Allen and Annie Aseltine. He was preceded in death by his brother David Evert.
