Reina Christine Mazzoni, 63, of Vermontville, died on October 16, 2016 in Charlotte. Reina was born on April 15, 1953, to Raymond L. Reed and Vivian (Backus) Ulrich in Lansing. Reina graduated from Haslett High School. On October 7, 1972, Reina married Clifford Mazzoni in Lansing. Reina worked as a skilled Metal Finisher for General Motors, until her retirement in 2014.

Reina's love for gathering the family together, and for cooking, made every Thanksgiving extra special. The family said "she is the reason the family did well." Reina, as her family said, "was her own woman; she ran the household, but was very independent." She rode her own Harley, with Cliff and friends; and participated in Street Rod Nationals in Kalamazoo. Other things Reina enjoyed were fishing, playing the slot machines at the casino, traveling with her girlfriend to the Caribbean, and most of all, spending time with her family. A wonderful memory is of Reina camping with her granddaughters each summer, for a full week. The family shared that Reina didn't have much growing up, but that didn't stop her from sharing and giving to her children and granddaughters. Another quote from the family, and how she would want to be remembered, is, "When she put her mind to something, she did it!"

Reina Mazzoni is survived by her husband Clifford; her daughter Tobi (Justin) Brummette; brother Rob Reed of Lansing, and sister Paula Steele of Vermontville, her granddaughters, Sadie and Marcie, and her parents. She

was predeceased by her son, Troy, in 2011; and her brother, Randy Reed.

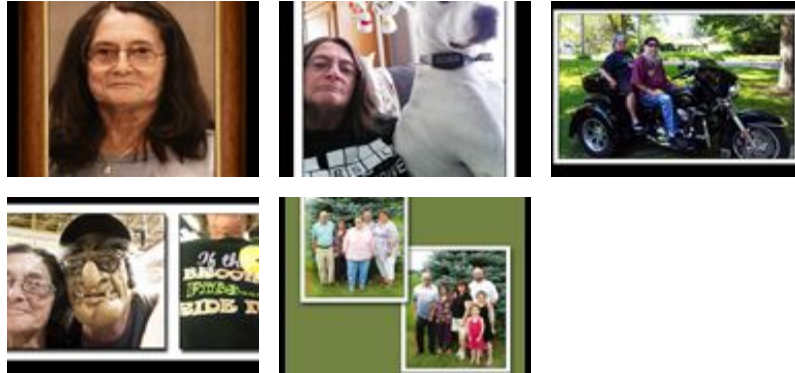
