Robert "Bob" Ames Menzie, a hardworking, loyal man who loved his country, died on Tuesday, September 13, 2022. Bob 77, of Charlotte was born October 22, 1944, in Indianapolis, IN, the son of Marquis and Shirley (Templeton) Menzie. Shortly after graduating from high school at the age of 17 Bob received special permission from his parents to join the United States Marine Corp. Bob proudly served his country during the Vietnam era. Upon his return from the war Bob married the love of his life Beverly Gall in 1968. Bob worked as an Ohio State Trooper, and later as a Security Guard at the GM plant. He was able to climb the ranks through GM. He obtained a Bachelor's Degree and would become a supervisor for one of GM's largest plants. He was later transferred to Charlotte and this is where his family made their roots for the last 40 plus years. Bob was an avid outdoorsman, he loved hunting, fishing, gardening, and doing yardwork. He also enjoyed watching baseball and football. Reading was also a big part of Bob's life. He devoted his life to the Lord and was very active with his church. Above all Bob's biggest passion in life was his hard work ethic and his ability to provide for his family.

Bob is survived by his children, Shawn (Tina) Menzie, Nathan (Christi) Menzie, Heather (Josh) Menzie, and Kayla Menzie; grandchildren, Samuel, and Gabriel; brother, Mark (Holly) Menzie. He was predeceased by his wife of over 48 years, Beverly; brother, Alan Menzie; and his parents.

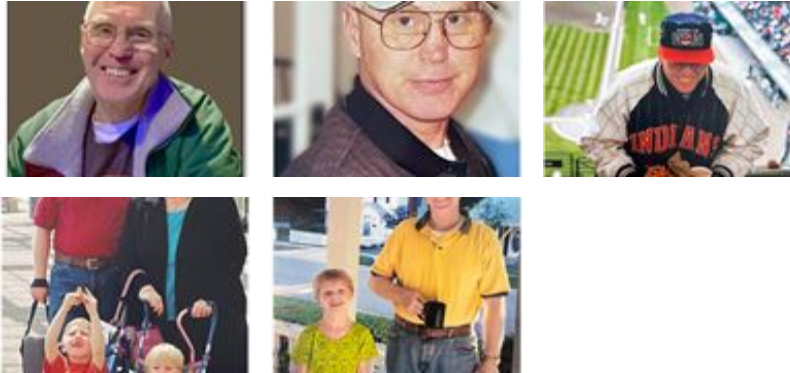
