Robert Lee Morris, 41 Years, of Battle Creek, formerly of Charlotte, passed away unexpectedly on October 7, 2017 in Charlotte, MI. He was born on April 11, 1976 to Michael and Annette (Rugg) Morris in Lansing, MI. Bob attended Charlotte High School and later worked as a Construction Worker for many years in Battle Creek.
